

STADIUM STOMPERS IS A MOVE-MENT OF COMMUNITY MEMBER AND STUDENTS COMING TO-GETHER TO STOP TEMPLE'S STADI-UM AND BUILD POWER IN NORTH PHILLY.

Who is involved?

Temple University proposed to build a new \$126 million football stadium in the middle of a residential neighborhood of North Philadelphia. Community members, Temple students, and Temple faculty disagree with the proposed stadium, and are coming together to fight it, as the Stadium Stompers.

Where are they proposing to put the stadium?

The current proposal shows the stadium in between Broad St & 16th St and Norris St & Polett Walk: This potentially includes the Amos Recreation Center which has a playground, basketball courts and a swimming pool. "This park has been here forever...There are kids here, there's an after-school


program here, there's basketball games here all the time. It gives kids an outlet." - Krima Stevens (Temple News Article)

How will residents be affected?

As seen in the above image, the proposed stadium will be directly across the street from many homes. North Philly residences already struggle with the current demands Temple puts their neighborhood: "Multiple residents said neighbors in the area and other blocks surrounding campus struggle to

tolerate the noise of loud parties on special occasions,

but also with noisy early-morning practices from the marching band." - Temple News



When do they want to start building?

In the fall of 2016, Temple University announced construction on the stadium will be postponed until 2018, due to internal conflicts and community pressure. In 2018, the stadium proposal was tabled and the money for the project was reallocated to other athletics programs.
